



The Jeddah Corniche Circuit is a 6.174 km motor racing circuit built in the Red Sea port city of Jeddah, in Saudi Arabia. The circuit staged the inaugural Saudi Arabian Grand Prix as the penultimate race on the 2021 Formula One season calendar.

The circuit was designed by Carsten Tilke, son of the famed circuit designer, Hermann Tilke. The BOX Seat 901 and 908 Models were selected to seat the race fans on various stands at the track.
